



## ***Lifepath Systems*** ***Home and Community Services Program (HCS)***

### ***About HCS***

The HCS Program provides individualized services and supports to persons with mental retardation who are living with their family, in their own home or in other community settings, such as small group homes. The HCS program requires that you place an individual with development disabilities name on an interest list for an HCS slot. Once the person has received a slot, services are available to that person. To add your name or a family member's name to the interest list, please call LifePath offices at (972) 727-9133.

### ***Services***

- Case management
- Nursing
- Residential assistance
  - ❖ Supported home living – community activities, volunteer work, basic living skills training, etc.
    - ✓ Foster/companion care (24/7 supervision)
    - ✓ Supervised living (3 bed home 24/7 supervision)
    - ✓ Residential support (4 bed home 24/7 supervision)
- Respite (in-home for supported home living consumers)
- Day habilitation
- Supported employment (competitive community employment)
- Dental treatment (up to \$1,000 per year)
- Therapies: speech/language pathology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, dietary services and psychology)
- Adaptive aids (up to \$10,00 per year)
- Minor home modifications (up to \$7,500 lifetime limit)

### ***Eligibility Requirements***

- No age limit
- Not be enrolled in another Medicaid waiver program
- Have had a determination of mental retardation in accordance with state law or have been diagnosed by a physician as having a related condition
- Have chosen the HCS Program over the ICF/MR Program or other Waiver programs
- Financial eligibility is determined by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission. For more information, please visit their website:
