



Answers to Questions asked by prospective bidders on the BLOOMDALE CAMPUS FURNITURE RFP# 0137

- Question #1: Do you use any GPO Contracts? Vizient, Premier, HealthTrust?
Answer #1: LifePath Systems does not currently utilize any GPO contracts.
- Question #2: Since this is 'Collin County' do they have any ownership that would qualify you to access other government type contracts for pricing? Omnia, Tips, etc.
Answer #2: There is no ownership that would qualify LifePath Systems to access other government type of contracts for pricing.
- Question #3: Are there any GPO or healthcare contracts that you would like the pricing to follow? Examples: Vizient, Premier, HealthTrust, Omnia, etc?
Answer #3: There are currently no GPO or healthcare contracts that LifePath Systems would like the pricing to follow.
- Question #4: Will there be a 3D CAD file provided?
Answer #4: LifePath Systems will not provide a copy of a 3D CAD file.
- Question #5: Are we able to submit a list of alts to be reviewed/approved before submitting with pricing?
Answer #5: LifePath Systems is requiring submission of all documentation on response due date.
- Question #6: Will the installation be completed at once, or phased by floor?
Answer #6: The installation will be completed at once.
- Question #7: Do the products on this bid need to be on a specific contract or GPO?
Answer #7: The products on this bid do not need to be on a specific contract or GPO.
- Question #8: Can we propose alternatives that are not on the approved list? If not, there will be multiple vendors that will have to be awarded the project.
Answer #8: Any and all alternates should be considered, if the look/function is similar.
- Question #9: T14, T14B, T17: What are the power requirements/power modules that are required?
Answer #9: There are no specific power requirement/power modules as any and all alternates should be considered, as long as the look/function is similar.
- Question #10: What are the lock requirements for storage and office furniture? Keyed alike? Keyed differently?
Answer #10: Lock requirements for storage and office furniture will be keyed differently.
- Question #11: S1: What is the Pull finish?
Answer #11: Standard options should be proposed.



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Question #12: Lateral Files – do you want them counterweighted or wall mounts?

Answer #12: Lateral Files should be wall mounted.

Question #13: TC1 – do you want a seat slider?

Answer #13: LifePath Systems is only requiring a basic ergonomic chair.

Question #14: Does a Manual lift mechanism refer to a tabletop option or a pneumatic height adjustable table base? Additionally, is manual lift acceptable or does it have to be pneumatic?

Answer #14: Any and all alternates should be considered, as long as the look/function is similar.

Question #15: If the crank height adjustable is more expensive than a regular HAT, do you still want it quoted?

Answer #15: Our intent with the crank option was long term maintenance.

Question #16: Can we propose Steelcase when the base bid is MillerKnoll or Teknion (a closed line)?

Answer #16: Any and all alternates should be considered, as long as the look/function is similar.

Question #17: Does LifePath qualify for any government contracts?

Answer #17: LifePath Systems qualifies for all government contracts.

Question #18: Please confirm if they are or are not tax exempt.

Answer #18: LifePath Systems is a tax-exempt agency.

Question #19: Since we received the BID a week after the initial date, is there an extension to the due date of 9/30. If not, what time is the response due on the 30th.
