MVPN Volunteer Responsibilities

Peer to Peer Volunteers:

- Assist program participants in the development of skills, confidence, and relationships to cope with unsolicited challenges of life.
- Facilitate groups in an open and welcoming environment.
- Provide direct peer support based on your own lived experiences.
- Help educate veteran and families to understand recovery strategies.

Veteran Facilitators:

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation of group sessions and individual progress.
- Conduct peer group sessions following the established protocols and guidelines of the MVPN program.
- Maintain a supportive environment for participants to share their experiences.
- Facilitate discussions and encourage active participation from group members.

Veteran Supporters:

- Support individuals through shared knowledge, beliefs, and experiences that promote recovery and wellness.
- Support an individual in their recovery journey through advocacy, modeling skills, behavior, education, and assistance with navigating the system of care.

Mentor Treatment Court:

- Help mentees identify their goals and devise strategies for helping them to achieve them.
- Provide advice and guidance on personal and professional development.
- Support mentees in overcoming challenges and setbacks.
- Share insights, experiences, and knowledge to broaden mentees' perspectives.
- Monitor mentees' progress and provide constructive feedback.
- Identify opportunities for mentees to develop new skills or gain relevant experience.

Outreach Supporters:

- Assist in maintaining a calendar of outreach activities, including community events, workshops, appearances, and other communication opportunities.
- Nurturing new and old relationships with collaborative communities.
- Scheduling regular outreach exhibitions in the community and educate veterans on military benefits.
- Assisting in the organization of special events, including veteran/volunteer appreciation events and other MVPN activities/initiatives.
- Collaborating with community stakeholders on collecting items veterans may need such as, food, clothing, perishable items, etc.
